
PICKPOCKETING VISIBLE PERSONAL EFFECTS,_Y YOU'RE A TARGET!

When on the move or on public transport:

Keep your bag closed and in sight

Beware of malicious glances while putting valuables inside your bag







SNATCH THEFT PHONE OUT, WATCH OUT!

Report the theft of your phone to your operator so your line can be suspended

Quickly go to a police station to file a complaint







SNATCH THEFT DON'T BE RECKLESS, WATCH YOUR NECKLACE!

Keep pictures of your jewellery

IF YOU ARE A VICTIM:

Memorise the attacker's appearance

Immediately call 17 or go to a police station to file a complaint







THEFT FROM UNATTENDED VEHICLES YOUR CAR IS NOT (A) SAFE!

Always lock windows & doors

Do not leave objects in plain sight (GPS holders, cables, etc.)

Do not hide your IDs in the trunk, the glove box or under the seat
